



PHONICS

We're excited to be entering our third year of teaching the phonics programme, Little Wandle Letters and Sounds.



We have had a strong start in Reception, beginning teaching as soon as our children all began. From our first day, we were practising our letter formation! We are really proud of our efforts to learn eight new sounds: s, a, t, p, i, n, m and d. This week, we've started to learn how to blend those sounds together so we can read words like sat, sit, tip and nap. Soon we will be bringing home our first reading books to practise!




In Year 1, over the past couple of weeks, we have been reviewing and revising phase 3 and 4 GPC's and tricky words from phases 2 4. This has been a good opportunity for the children to refresh their phonics skills and extend their spelling knowledge.



Year 2 have been busy continuing to learn their phase 5 sounds. They have also been working hard to develop their decoding, prosody and comprehension skills during their reading practice group sessions



Every reading session matters and re-reading books helps to build fluency (reading automatically), a skill that's more easily mastered with practise





Top Tip! If your child is unsure of a word when they are reading, don't be tempted to jump right in. See if they can work it out independently. If they are unsure, say, 'Can you spot a digraph?
