<p><u>Draw and Make</u> Design and create your own mosaics tile using a material of your choice.</p>	<p><u>Draw and Make</u> Draw your own family crest that would go on your Roman shield. Perhaps you could add in some Latin writing?</p>	<p><u>Draw and Make</u> Can you make a Roman Villa using a shoe box or Lego? Make sure you research the different rooms and areas of the house.</p>
<p><u>Research</u> Research all the different usages of plants. Why are they so important to the world? What would happen if these plants were to be taken away? Create a list of your favourite plants including what they provide.</p>	<p><u>Research</u> In PSHE we are learning about our 'Rights and Responsibilities'. Research what rights you have. Can you find any charities that work to ensure the rights for children around the world? E.g. Oxfam, Unicef, Save the Children, NSPCC etc. (Research with an adult)</p>	<p><u>Research</u> Create a food chain starting with plants as a producer. Can you make it an energy chain? What gives the producer energy?</p>
<p><u>Write</u> Rewrite yourself into your favourite myth or legend. What character will you play? Will you have an impact on the ending?</p>	<p><u>Write</u> Pretend you are a Roman soldier and write a letter back to your family telling them what you are doing.</p>	<p><u>Write</u> In RE we are learning about how and why we mark significant events in our lives. Write about a significant time in your life and how you celebrated. Perhaps you could add photos to it.</p>
<p><u>Maths</u> Make a clock (you can use a paper plate) and write the numbers in Roman numerals.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> There are angles and lines all around us in nature. Go on a hunt to find as many as you can. Record and label what you have found. Right angle, acute, obtuse, parallel, perpendicular, diagonal, horizontal and vertical.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Set up a shop in your house with household items and create your own coins and notes from paper. Can your family come and purchase items? You need to give them change, perhaps you could even write them a receipt to show that you have given the correct change.</p>
